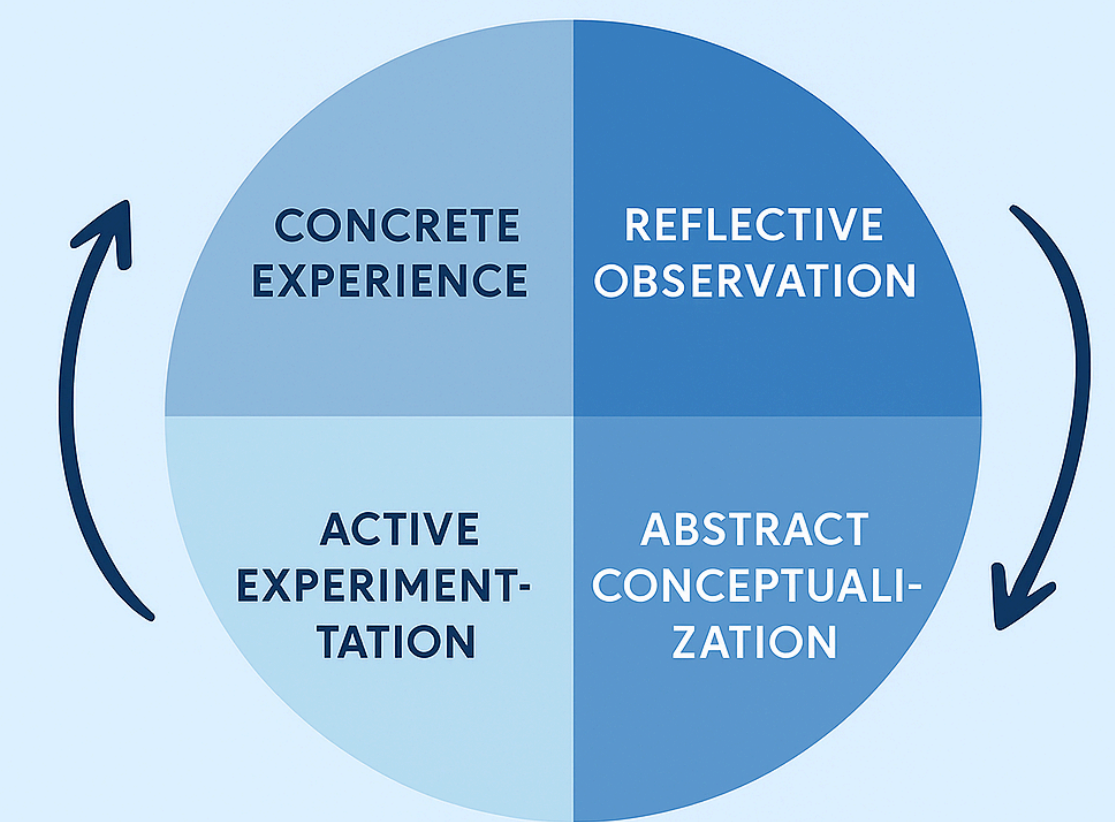
## INTRODUCTION & PURPOSE
